ANTARCTICA

Access the White Continent from the rarely traversed Ross Sea by way of Tasmania, or venture into the Weddell Sea from South America. Visit historic “huts” and research stations, explore the Antarctic Peninsula, embark on epic quests for penguin colonies, and look for whales and wildlife amidst the extraordinary wilderness.

ROSS ISLAND, ANTARCTICA

Ross Island is home to Scott's 'Terra Nova' Hut at Cape Evans, base for Captain Robert Scott's ill-fated British Antarctic Expedition of 1910-13, and Sir Ernest Shackleton's hut at Cape Royds, used as base for his attempt on the south pole during his 1907-09 expedition, and also home to the world's southern-most penguin colony. Both huts sit remarkably intact at the foot of Mt Erebus, an active volcano. Scott named the island for Sir James Ross, who discovered it in 1841 in command of HMS Erebus.
